

Utilities Code

182.052

- + Gov. operated utility may not disclose personal info.
- → You can withhold this info without AG brief.
- → Covers: address, phone number, social security number.

552.1331

- Information collected through metering system.
- → You do not need to write a brief to withhold.
- → Covers: volume/usage and delinquent account or shutoff lists.





Family Code

261.201

- → Report of alleged or suspected abuse or neglect of child (under 18).
- → Special right of access.

58.008

- → Law enforcement records concerning a child who is alleged to have engaged in delinquent conduct.
- → Special right of access.



Occupations Code

159.002

- Medical Practice Act.
- → Continues to apply regardless of when communications were made.




Health & Safety Code

773.091

- → EMS Records.
- → Continues to apply regardless of when communications were made.

611.002

→ Communications between patient and a professional, and records of the identify, diagnosis, evaluation, or treatment of a patient that are created or maintained by a professional.




Education Code

→ Teacher Evaluations - Evaluation documents on the performance of a teacher or administrator.





Federal Statutes

ADA

→ Info collected from an applicant or employee concerning the individual's medical condition and medical history.






